



- 1 entry and exit point to cheltenham road
- 2 realigned shared path connects to existing north - south path network
- 3 realigned swale and relocated pond
- 4 proposed roundabout
- 5 proposed car parks
- 6 existing car park to be enhanced
- 7 pedestrian promenade access to springers leisure centre
- 8 proposed forecourt plaza area
- 9 retain drop off to springers leisure centre entry
- 10 drop off area access from new north - south road
