An Excess Animals Permit is required to keep more than two dogs or two cats. Failure to obtain a Permit can result in penalty infringement notices being issued and excess animals being seized

All dogs and cats must be registered by the age of three months.

The owners of a dog or cat who fail to register their pet are liable for on the spot penalties.

A child's (person under 17 years of age) dog or cat must be registered in the parent's or guardian's name.

Please note: Under State Legislation, all dogs and cats registered for the first time or being relocated from another municipality must be microchipped. Council cannot complete the processing of your application until proof of microchipping is provided.

Registration Tags

Registration tags and numbers are not given out every year. Keep your tag for the life of your dog/cat.

Replacement Tags

Free replacement tags are available from Council customer service centres or by calling 8571 1000

Restricted Breeds

The following dogs are restricted breeds;

Pitbull Terrier/American Pitbull Terrier
Fila Brasileiro
Dogo Argentino
Japanese Tosa

Note: Declared Dangerous, Menacing or Restricted Breed dogs are not eligible for any fee concessions.

Proof of Desexing

A desexing certificate must be provided at the time of registration. If you do not have a certificate, contact your veterinarian

Microchip Identification

Microchip Certificate or a Statutory Declaration stating the number must be provided. If you do not have a certificate, contact your veterinarian

Responsible Pet Ownership











Council impounds hundreds of dogs and cats each year. In 75% of cases, we return dogs to their owners within three days. This is because the animal is either wearing its Council Registration Tag or is microchipped. It is a legal requirement that your animal is wearing its Council Registration Tag when it is off your property. Penalties apply for wandering dogs or cats not wearing tags.

Unfortunately, only 3% of impounded cats are returned to their owners, so it is even more important to microchip your cat and make sure it is wearing its registration tag.

Many people object to having other peoples cats trespassing on their properties, and so they take advantage of Council's Cat Trapping Program. If your cat is trapped and not identified by means of a microchip or council tag we will not be able to return your cat to you. It is illegal for your cat to trespass on other people's properties.

Payment options:

- 1) Post or email form with microchip certificate and proof of desexing (if desexed) to City of Greater Dandenong, PO Box 200, DANDENONG VIC 3175 and Council will contact you to facilitate a credit card payment over the phone.
- 2) Post form with cheque/money order , microchip certificate and proof of desexing (if desexed) to the City of Greater Dandenong, PO Box 200, DANDENONG VIC 3175
- 3) Come to the customer service centre and hand in the form with the microchip certificate and proof of desexing (if desexed) and pay in person.
