



# CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

SPRINGVALE BOULEVARD PROJECT  
MAY 2022

**The Springvale Boulevard Project will see a full upgrade of the road and footpaths located on Springvale Road between Balmoral Avenue and Windsor Avenue.**

## What we've done so far

Since our last update we have:

- Removed the existing footpath on western side of Springvale Road
- Finalised roadside kerb installation on the eastern side of Springvale Road
- Continued with roadside kerb installation on the western side of Springvale Road, with both sides of Springvale Road near completion
- Constructed the concrete base at Post Office Lane and Windsor Avenue
- Started installing designed pavers at Post Office Lane and Windsor Avenue.

## Construction impacts

Moving into Stage 3 of the project, we are progressing with earthworks. These works create dust and increase noise. We are monitoring our dust levels and have started implementing water trucks to reduce dust levels to help mitigate the impact to the community.

## What is coming up

In May we will:

- Construct the concrete base and install designed pavers at the pedestrian crossing on the western side of Springvale Road, and out the front of lane 248 Springvale Road
- During night shift later in May (to minimise impact on traders) we will finalise roadside kerb along western side of Springvale Road and install asphalt on both sides of Springvale Road.
- Finalise roadside kerb along western side of springvale road install asphalt on both sides of springvale road, these works are planned for later in may and will be completed during night shift to reduce impacts on traders
- Finalise electrical, communications and traffic infrastructure
- Begin to install street furniture, including new street chairs
- Start landscaping including planting trees.



## Changed traffic conditions

During the works there will be changes to traffic conditions, with two lanes maintained in each direction.

At certain times we may need to close one lane to allow our works to occur safely. Please be aware and look out for signage and traffic controllers.

## Change to footpath conditions

As we progress with the Springvale Boulevard Project, we may need to alter the width of the footpaths along Springvale Road. We understand this can be frustrating for traders and apologise for any inconvenience, will continue to minimise these impacts as much as possible.

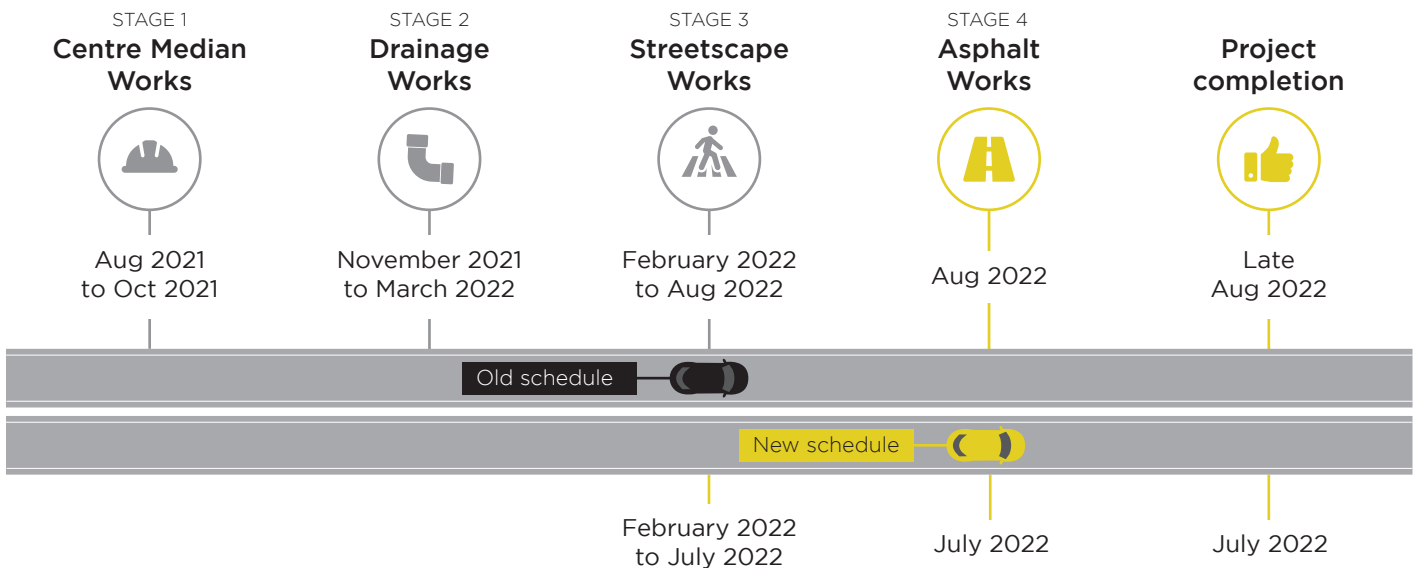
## Working hours

Most of our works in May will be day works and undertaken between 7am and 5.30pm, Monday to Friday.

Occasionally, night works will take place between 6pm and 6am, Sunday to Thursday. We will notify you ahead of any night works that need to occur.

## Project completion ahead of schedule

We are pleased to announce our project completion is ahead of schedule. At the current work rate, we anticipate project completion will be in July, one month ahead of originally planned.
